To allow for the selection process to occur, applications will not be accepted after March 1, 2012.

The Following guidelines should be followed:

1. The candidate must be a member of an OIPA pageantry unit.
2. The candidate's unit must attend OIPA Championships to be eligible.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries per unit.
4. The scholarship will be granted for one year, but recipients may re-apply the next year if he/she remains active with an unit and meets all the requirements listed.
5. A committee of non-affiliated community leaders will make the selections for who will be awarded at OIPA Championships.
