CLINICIANS

Sal Salas

Sal's career in the Pageantry Arts has spanned over 45 years, and has not only been diverse, but extremely successful in all areas. Serving as everything from instructor to designer to director to judge, Sal's commitment to youth and excellence has seen no bounds. Highlights of his pageantry resume include his recent position as the Executive Director of the Madison Scouts, his involvement as a judge for Winter Guard International since 2004 (as well as various circuits throughout Wisconsin, Ohio, Florida and Illinois), marching band judge, and his role as the founder and director of the five time Winter Guard International Gold Medalist 'The State Street Review'. Sal's honors include his being named the 2005 Drum Corps International Director of the Year, being a recipient of the prestigious WGI Hall of Fame Award in 1993 and in 2009 inducted into the WGASC Hall of Fame. Sal most recently taught the Bronze Medalist Juxtaposition Winter Guard in 2009. Sal is also the program coordinator for the 2010 Glassmen Drum and Bugle Corps from Toledo, OH.

Fred Feeney

A former member of the Blue Stars in the late 70's and staff member in the early 80's, Fred served as Chief Judge for Winter Guard International for 12 years and on the WGI Task Force for several years before assuming that position. He is currently a member of the WGI Board of Directors. He has also been the Chief Judge of the Gulfcoast Judges Association, an organization that services four different color guard and indoor percussion circuits throughout the Southeast, for over 20 years. In addition to his work judging for WGI, he has also judged for DCI and various band circuits across the country.

Feeney received his undergraduate degree from the University of Southern Mississippi and a law degree from Mississippi College. In his life away from pageantry he is a partner in a Gulfport, Mississippi law firm.

Mykail Costner

Mykail Costner has been an instructor, designer, performer, and choreographer for 5-time WGI Independent World Class Champion Fantasia. In addition to a long list of achievements, he has instructed many great organizations including the Santa Clara Vanguard, the Crossmen, the Glassman, and the Crossmen Drum and Bugle Corps. Indoors, Mykail has had the pleasure of working with James Logan High School (CA), Mt. Carmel High School (CA), Valencia High School (CA), and James Bowie High School (TX). He has worked with band programs such as the Riverside Community College Marching Tigers, 2007 Bands Of America Grand National Champion LD Bell High School (Hurst, TX), and 2006 BOA Grand National Champion Broken Arrow High School (OK), and Connally High School in Austin, TX. Mykail is often called upon as a design consultant and clinician for bands and guards across the United States.

Michael Rosales

Michael was born in Manila, Philippines, moved to San Francisco at the age of 9 where he trained and danced with several local groups within the San Francisco Bay Area. His training in Ballet, Jazz, Modern, Hip-Hop, Latin Jazz and Color Guard makes him one of the most sought after choreographers in the country. He has danced for recording artists such as **Ricky Martin, Deborah Cox, Brooke Hogan, Wisin y Yandel, Ivy Queen, Gloria Trevy, and Macy Gray**. As well as being on a National and International Tour of the Tony and Emmy award winning group **BLAST!** as a lead, he was also a feature performer and was in a new show called **CYBERJAM** in London where he was the Choreographer Assistant. Michael has performed throughout the United States, Europe and Asia. He has appeared in the Blockbuster movie **RENT**, Latin Billboard Awards, Latin Grammy's Celebration and the Latin Teen Choice Awards. He has also taught classes at the San Francisco Dance Center, Miami City Ballet, University of Houston, North Carolina State University, Pepperdine University, University of Miami, UC Berkeley, Moving People Dance Company in Santa Fe and several different studios throughout the country. Michael has produced and choreographed shows for Busch Gardens in Florida, Sea World in Texas, the FED EX Orange Bowl Halftime Show, The University of Houston and is the co-founder of **TAE Talent Agency** in Miami.

Michael was a former member of the **Concord Blue Devils, Fantasia of Riverside and the San Jose Raiders**. He has worked with the Braddock Independent World, the Bluecoats Drum Corp and Color Guard, Cadets Color Guard, Stoneman Douglas World, FIU Performance Ensemble and West Broward High School Color Guard among other groups. Michael was also a Gold Medal recipient of the 1998 as well as the 2000 Winter Guard International World Championships and is the Artistic Director of the **PROJECT SPIN Dance and Color Guard Convention**.
